“Paul’s Driving Motivations”
2 Corinthians 5:14-15

Observing the text

Read 2 Corinthians 5:14-15 carefully and make as many observations as possible.

How do these verses fit into the flow of the text?

Who is the “all” that Paul is referring to in 2 Corinthians 5:14?

What is the significance of Christ having died for “all?”

How should this knowledge impact the way we live our lives?

Applying the sermon

Do you believe that Christ, in order to save you, died your death for you? Why?

How often do you think about what He did for you? How do these thoughts concerning His love for you motivate you to live your life in a manner pleasing to Him?

Are you presently satisfied with how you are living your life in light of what you know about Christ and what He has done for you? If not, what are you going to do about this?

Please pray and express your thoughts to God, asking Him for the grace to follow through on what you believe you should do.
